This addendum modifies the Wedding & Event Rental Contract, and replaces the Section on Releases on Page 4 of the contract, as specified below:
Only butterflies provided through The Elizabethan Gardens, Inc. may be released in the Gardens. The JSDA regulates what butterflies may be released in each state, and our supplier has the proper permits and disease control protocols in place to protect the wild population.
Butterflies are extremely fragile, and must be shipped UPS or FedEx next day air services, which is ncluded in the pricing below. North Carolina Sales Tax is also included in the pricing.

Temperatures need to be a minimum of 65 degrees to release butterflies into the wild. If the
weather does not permit that, the butterfly house is available for guests to use to release the butterflies
Payment is due at time of contract, as butterflies are raised for each order.
The Gardens Staff has a certified Butterfly Release coordinator, who will go over the care and release instructions with the designated person for the wedding or the event coordinator prior to cransferring the butterflies into the custody of the designated person. Staff is not able to hand out putterflies to guests, or tend them during your event.

Butterflies may NOT be left in direct sunlight prior to release  If the outdoor temperature is less than 65 degrees at the time of the release, the Butterflies will be released into the Butterfly House
